PALMA — MALLORCA

DAY 1

Welcome to the capital of Mallorca. You will start your journey Puerto Portals, just 15 minutes from the airport. This charming old town deserves stroll with its chic boutiques, stunning cathedral and delightful blend of bars, cafes and other historical buildings.

A lovely stop to make is the 11th century Arab Baths. As one of the more popular sites in the city, the heavy traffic has taken its toll on the monument, leaving some areas a little worse for wear. However, the location is also home to some splendid gardens which are home to many local flora and fauna as well as birds and palm trees. In the evening, return back to port for dinner at the classic Spanish restaurant, Flannigans or a delectable Asian fusion food at the Spoon Restaurant.



ANDRATX / DRAGONERA ISLAND — MALLORCA

DAY 2

After enjoying breakfast, admire the stunning views of the sea as you cruise to Andratx. Andratx is nestled in to the south eastern corner of the main island and features some of the most staggering scenery that Majorca has to offer. With the main towns built into valleys, there are some close knit communities to see which give you a true insight into the way the Spanish live on the islands. Take your pick from the wide variety of water toys **KATHLEEN ANNE** has to offer and enjoy the afternoon in the refreshing sparkling waters.

IBIZA PORT

DAY 6

Registered as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the harbour of Ibiza Town shows some typically Spanish architecture. Ideal for holiday photographs, the old town makes an interesting afternoon and shows some nods to the history of this famous island.

As the sun goes down your day in Ibiza truly begins. The legendary nightlife hasn't gained a reputation for nothing, so try out a handful of venues to get a taste of everything that's on offer. Regular parties are held on the beaches, in addition to special themed nights in the clubs. If you prefer a quieter evening, there are some more timid venues with good food, and table to table musical entertainment.

CALA JONDAL — IBIZA

DAY 6

Recover from the night before by cruising to Cala Jondal for a spectacular beach day. Cala Jondal is a very beautiful beach, surrounded by pines and jagged cliffs, very popular with boat owners and a stylish crowd.

Overlooked only by a few exquisitely architected homes high up on the surrounding green hills, the white pebbly beach is dotted here and there with the shade of pine trees before sloping to the glittering, crystal clear waters. Many beach clubs build up sandy parts and provide safe access into the water with little bridges or ramps. After a few metres the seabed is sandy, so bathing is pure joy.

ES TRENC BEACH — MALLORCA DAY 7

Make your way back to beautiful Mallorca, but this time, on the South Eastern part of the island. Stretching just over 2 km of fine sand, find the beach of Es Trenc. Unspoilt, remote and surrounded by natural, wild beauty, Es Trenc beach has been named as one of the best beaches in Mallorca. Many have compared it to beaches in the Caribbean due to its pure white sand and bright blue water.

The erosion of these cliffs is what provides the soft sandy bottom of this beach. Enjoy a beach picnic here, among flowering vegetation beautifully contrasting with the rough surrounding cliffs.


